Residential Trip to Kingswood, Bembridge, Isle of Wight 8th May – 10th May 2024

We are arranging a residential trip for pupils in year 10 to Kingswood, Bembridge, Isle of Wight. This is a residential centre offering the opportunity for pupils to participate in a wide range of team and confidence building activities which may include archery, climbing, bush craft and orienteering. It is always a valuable and rewarding experience. You can visit their website for more information. https://www.kingswood.co.uk/locations/isle-of-wight

We will be transporting the pupils to Bembridge by school minibuses and an appropriate ratio of Woodlands Meed staff will be present at all times as well as qualified and experienced instructors from Kingswood.

We will leave college on Wednesday 8th May and will return on Friday 10th May, exact timings will be confirmed nearer the time.

The approx. cost per pupil is £252.00, but this may vary slightly as the cost of the ferry is yet to be confirmed. If you would like your child to attend we require a £53.00 deposit by 13th October, in order to secure the booking with Kingswood.

If the trip does not go ahead due to lack of interest the deposit will be returned to you, however should you later change your mind once the trip is confirmed we will not be able to provide you with a refund.

Please see below a payment schedule with due dates and costs, which can be paid using your Scopay account.

The school is entitled to charge for the board and lodging element of the residential trip, voluntary contributions will be sought to cover the remaining costs. However, in accordance with our Charging and Remissions and Pupil Premium Policies (which can be found on our website), the school will cover the cost of the board and lodgings for families who qualify for Pupil Premium. If you are unsure whether your son / daughter qualifies for pupil premium please contact the school to check.
