This edition takes a look at the pathways available and a closer look at Supported Internships.





A Supported Internship is an unpaid work-based study programme that usually lasts for a year. You will spend the majority of your time in the workplace, developing your skills for employment.

It is a first step from education into the workplace while gaining the skills needed to get a paid job.

To apply for a Supported Internship you need to be:

- Aged 16-24 years old
- Hold an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)

A Supported Internship includes:

- An unpaid work placement of at least 6 months
- Support from a local Job Coach
- A study programme, including studying English and maths to an appropriate level

What happens afterwards?

The aim of a Supported Internship is to prepare you for working in a paid job. You could get a job at the same place you did your Supported Internship or you could look for a job with a different employer.
