Re: RSE (Relationship, Sex Education)

In the Spring term your son/daughter will be taking part in a bespoke RSE programme as part of our Relationship, Sex Education (RSE) curriculum. These lessons have been created to meet the needs of Key Stage Three students at Woodlands Meed School. The aim of the lessons is to expand the students' knowledge, understanding and confidence of what it means to build and maintain safe and healthy relationships, and to give the young people the knowledge and confidence to speak out, and know where to go for support, if they find themselves in a situation that makes them feel uncomfortable.

The topics which will be covered in each year group are as follows:

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The first lesson will be an assessment of the students so that we can further tailor the information to meet their needs and we can find out what they would like to know more about in RSE. The last lesson will also be an assessment to establish what the students have learned and to allow the staff to evaluate with the students how to improve RSE lessons in the future.

Staff are supporting students with many of these issues throughout the year and we know you are regularly discussing with your son/daughter many of these issues too. We hope to provide the students with a supported safe space to develop their understanding of the above themes.
