Residential Trip to Blackland Farm Outdoor Centre, East Grinstead 15th – 17th June 2026

We are arranging a residential trip for pupils in year 10 and year 12 to Blackland Farm Outdoor Centre, East Grinstead. This exciting residential experience will offer pupils the chance to stay in pre-pitched glamping bell tent accommodation, enjoy a full programme of adventurous activities, and benefit from full catering throughout their stay. We will be transporting the pupils to Blackland Farm by school minibuses and an appropriate ratio of Woodlands Meed staff will be present at all times as well as qualified and experienced instructors from Blackland Farm.

We will leave college on Monday 15th June and will return on Wednesday 17th June, exact timings will be confirmed nearer the time. If your child would like to camp, they will need to bring a sleeping bag and a camp bed. If providing these items is difficult, please let us know — we do not want this to be a barrier to participation.

The approx. cost per pupil is £148.63. If you would like your child to attend please log onto your scopay account to give consent and pay the £30.00 deposit by **22nd October**, in order to secure the booking with Blackland Farm.

If the trip does not go ahead due to lack of interest the deposit will be returned to you, however should you later change your mind once the trip is confirmed we will not be able to provide you with a refund.

Please see below a payment schedule with due dates and costs, which can be paid using your Scopay account.

The school is entitled to charge for the board and lodging element of the residential trip, voluntary contributions will be sought to cover the remaining costs. However, in accordance with our Charging and Remissions and Pupil Premium Policies (which can be found on our website), the school will cover the cost of the board and lodgings for families who qualify for Pupil Premium. If you are unsure whether your son / daughter qualifies for pupil premium or bursary please contact the school to check.


