I also need to stress that if a family were unable to contribute, and the trips were still to proceed, no child with the class/year group for whom the trips are intended will be disadvantaged and be left out of the activity.

Please send packed lunches in everyday, if your child is entitled to free school meals the school will provide a packed lunch each day this week. If you have already ordered a school dinner on these days, we will cancel the order and credit your account accordingly.

You will see Activity Week on your Scopay homepage under trips and events. Please log on to give consent for the week and make the voluntary donation if you wish. This must be done no later than **09:00am Friday 08th May**.

Please note that whilst we will do all we can to keep to the schedule advised it remains our priority to keep pupils & staff safe when off-site. If venue issues or our staffing levels mean we need to change the scheduled trips or activities at short notice, we will advise you immediately.
