Your child has chosen "Walking & Nature " for the autumn term as their enrichment activity. The Walking & Nature group run a series of different trips in the local area. The purpose of these visits is for the pupils to access the countryside and appreciate nature and the environment.

These visits will take places on Tuesday afternoons between Tuesday 15th September and Tuesday 20th October, the schedule is as follows:

- Tuesday 15th September - Ardingly reservoir Drought – impact on water Walk around Ardingly reservoir Talk about ways to conserve water (travel by minibus)
- Tuesday 22nd September - Batchelors Farm Orchard Drought – impact on plants Walk to Batchelors farm Look at fruit trees in the community Orchard (travel by minibus)
- Tuesday 29th September - Ditchling Common Identifying trees Take photos of leaves for identification (travel by minibus)
- Tuesday 6th October Jack and Jill Windmill South Downs Way Walk at pace along South Downs Way (travel by minibus)
- Tuesday 13th October - Bedelands Signs of Autumn Take photos of signs of Autumn - colours (travel by minibus)
- Tuesday 20th October - Footpaths Hassocks circular walk – incl. Oldlands Mill Footpath features & maintenance (travel by minibus)

On Tuesdays it is therefore necessary for pupils to wear sensible shoes for walking and bring a coat, water bottle and a snack if they wish.
