Forest School for Mountain Class

Your child will be taking part in Forest School weekly on Mondays during the Autumn term. This will take place on the school grounds.

Please can you make sure you send your child in with weather appropriate clothing such as a waterproof coat, gloves and hat for when it is cold and wellies due to the nature of the activities, please only send in clothes that you do not mind getting dirty.

Forest School provides children with the opportunity to explore and play in the natural environment. It works with children's intrinsic motivation to learn; we are lucky enough to have a lovely area with oak trees to hold forest school sessions in. The Forest School ethos is child-centred, and lessons are planned around the children's interests. At Forest School children work together on tasks which help to develop resilience, self-esteem, confidence, and social skills.
